



In 1960 Sand joined Chicago's famed Second City, becoming one of the group's first cast members, and collaborating with co-founder Paul Sills. In 1961 Sand appeared on Broadway in the Sills'-directed *From the Second City*, followed by Neil Simon's *The Star-Spangled Girl*. Sand's return to Broadway for the rep. production of *Paul Sills' Story Theatre & Ovid's Metamorphoses*, garnered him the Tony Award for Best Performance by a Featured Actor and two Drama Desk Awards. Paul's extensive TV and Film career includes roles in *Bewitched*, *The Mary Tyler Moore Show, Friends and Lovers, The Carol Burnett Show, Gimme a Break, St. Elsewhere, Wonder Woman, Taxi, Thirtysomething, The X-Files, Curb Your Enthusiasm, The Main Event, Chuck & Buck, and Sweet Land.*
